

IT'S ELECTION SEASON!

On **November 5th**, the there will be an important election that will determine the future of our state, and our country. Elected officials make laws that impact YOU! They determine, how much money will be spent on benefits, services and supports that you need.

Voting allows you to have a say in the future ---**YOUR** future.



To vote you must meet the following criteria:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Washington state
- At least 18 years old*
- Not disqualified from voting due to a court order If you are under guardianship, you can still vote, as long as the court has not taken that right away.
- Not currently in prison for a felony or federal or out-of-state felony conviction

*If you are 16 or 17, you can sign up as a **Future Voter** and be automatically

registered to vote when you qualify. In Washington state, 16- and 17-year-olds can sign up as Future Voters and be automatically registered to vote when they become eligible. A voter who turns 18 between the August Primary and the November General Election can vote in the Primary.



HOW DO I REGISTER TO VOTE?

To register and track your ballot visit <u>https://voter.votewa.gov/portal2023/login.aspx</u>.

On VoteWA you can view an election calendar, sign up for SMS text, update your voter information, and view your ballot status.

WHAT IF I NEED HELP TO VOTE?

Voters with disabilities have the right to request reasonable accommodations or assistance to vote.

Ballots Mailed Out	October 18th
Online and Mail Registrations (Must be Received 8 Days before Election)	October 26th
In person voting registration deadline	November 5th
