## **State Priorities**

- 1. Allies will Educate Various Communities about the need for Supportive Decision-Making Services: We believe people with intellectual and developmental disabilities should be presumed competent and never have all their rights taken from them.
- 2. Allies provides technical assistance to self-advocate organizations: We work with and assist Self-Advocates in Leadership, the Shut Them Down Coalition, and People First of Washington in their efforts to pass legislation and make lives better for those with I/DD.
- **3. Washington State Residents deserve better housing opportunities**: Allies want to see accessible, affordable, barrier-free housing in all communities that are safe for all residents. With the necessary supports provided, Allies desire to see various types of accessible and or barrier-free housing.
- **4. It's time to improve our provider pool!** Allies in Advocacy believe people with disabilities need high-quality provider support so we can lead meaningful lives in our communities. This means we will advocate for higher, improved pay and improved trainings for all providers.
- 5. **Improving relationships with medical and dental professionals:** Allies believe we need to help improve the relationship between people with disabilities and all first responders and medical and dental professionals.
- 6. **Accountability is key:** Allies will fight to create more accountability for State and local administration/organizations/businesses that serve people with disabilities.
- 7. **Nothing About Us Without Us:** Allies will be following how the implementation of the Nothing About Us Without Us Act is being implemented and helping locate people with disabilities to serve on Taskforces and Workgroups

## **Federal Priority**

1. **Self-Advocate Network Partner:** Allies and our state partners are advocating for a change to the federal DD Act, that would add an official state partner for self-advocacy of those with I/DD.
