Parent to Parent Support Programs of Washington State -

Washington State Parent to Parent (P2P) is a network of 22 Local County Programs, also with a Program at Seattle Children's Hospital currently supporting all counties in the state.

Activities include:

- Free, confidential services
- Matching parents in one-to-one relationships with skilled, experienced parents in the community based on diagnoses and family issues called Helping Parents.
- Follow-up by local County Coordinators on each P2P referral and help with systems navigation
- Culturally relevant services
- Support and social groups for the family
- Information/Educational Trainings
- Leadership trainings for parents who want to become volunteer Helping Parent (H/P) for matching
- Newsletters, Facebook & E-groups
