

# Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) Hospitalization With/Without Medical Need

## Hospital Clients Unable to Discharge

Supported Living (SL)/State Operated Living Alternative (SOLA) clients taken or admitted to an acute care hospital with a medical need and unable to discharge once the medical need is met. (Only 1 client was admitted without a medical need in February 2020.)

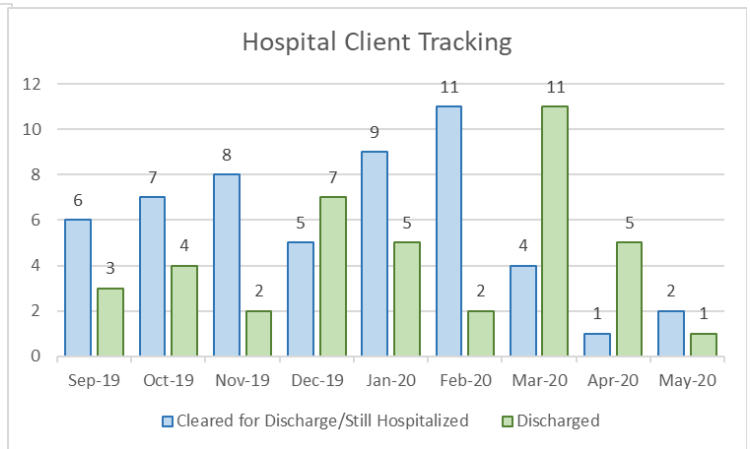
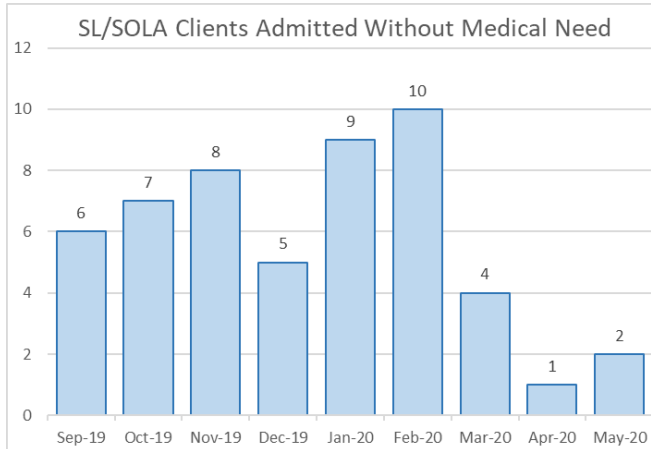


Chart represents SL/SOLA clients who are cleared by an acute care hospital and have not discharged as of the last day of the month. Client counts are duplicated. Cleared for discharge indicates hospital notified DDA staff that client no longer requires acute level of care. SL/SOLA clients brought to an acute care hospital for any physical and/or behavioral health concern is categorized as a medical need.

SL/SOLA client counts are duplicated and valid as of the last day of the month. Cleared for discharge indicates hospital notified DDA staff that client no longer requires acute level of care. Discharge activity represents clients who have discharged.
