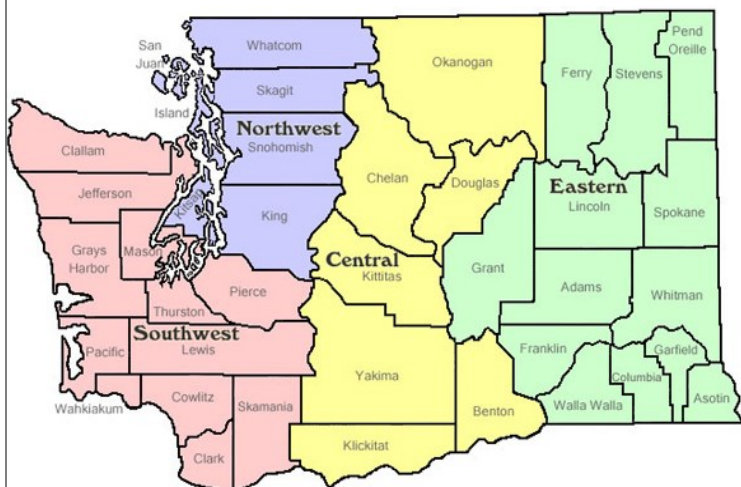


# Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) Transition Students by Year and County

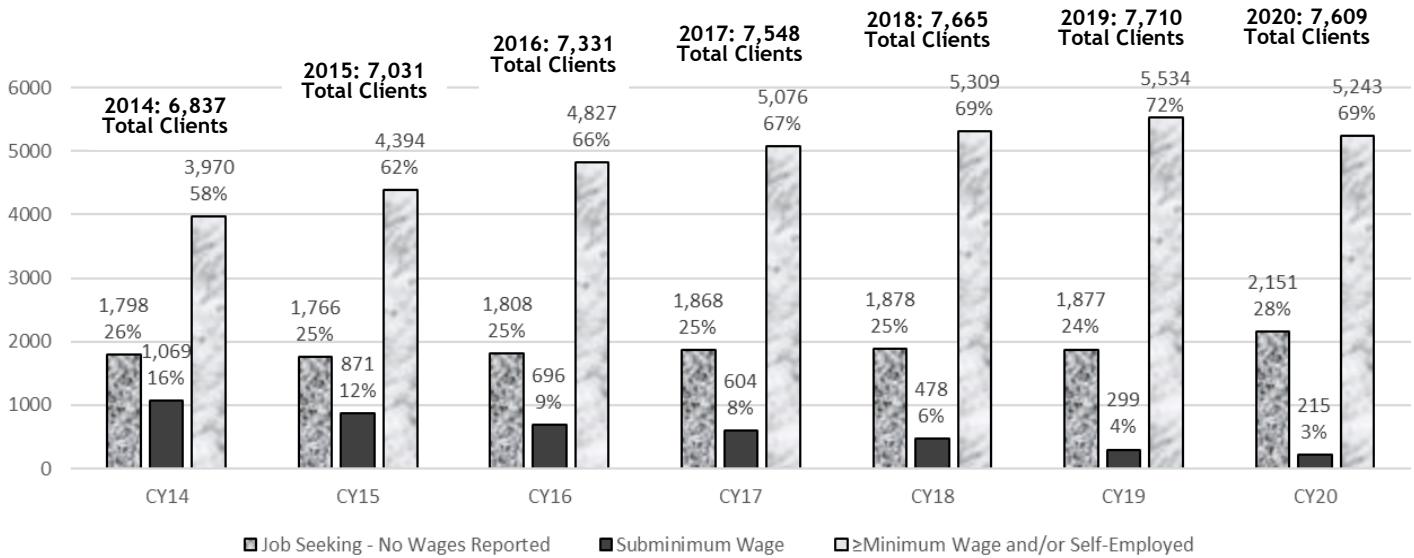
